Step 1 – Purchase your Ski Pass through link to Holiday Valley Club discount store

Regardless of whether you plan to ride the bus with us this season, use the following link to purchase your Holiday Valley Pass for this year's activities and share this with anyone who buys ski passes. Save money on your pass *AND* support the club!

Students who only ski with the club on Friday nights should purchase the "Ultimate Select – Friday" pass (\$225). At checkout you will be prompted to log in to your existing HV Store account, or create a new one, to process payment for your passes.

STUDENTS MAY BE EXCLUDED FROM SKI AND SNOWBOARD CLUB FOR THE ONE (1) CALENDAR YEAR FROM THE DATE OF THE INFRACTION, WHICH COULD RESULT IN EXCLUSION FOR THE SUBSEQUENT SCHOOL YEAR.
